If the Participant fails to act in accordance with these provisions, the representative of the Coordinator has the right to remove him from the continuation of the summer school without reimbursement of any costs or damages.

The Participant must agree with the home institution to obtain ECTS credits for attending the summer school.

If the Participant has to interrupt the summer school due to the loss of documents, he is not entitled to reimbursement of expenses or damage.

The Coordinator is not responsible for personal belongings and possessions of the Participant.
